Three Forks Chamber of Commerce Unapproved Minutes 09 July 2018

The July Chamber meeting was held at the Three Forks City Office. Present at the meeting were President, Brooke Leugers (Member); Vice-President, Karen Walton (Member); Secretary, J.R. Tonjum (JRNMT Inc.); Treasurer, Tanya Gonzalez (Tanya R. Gonzalez, CPA, PC); Board Member, Lane Pruett (Pathways Assisted Living), Board Member, Jeff Elliott (Three Forks School); Executive Director, Connie Hussung; Website Administrator, Katie LaLiberty; and the following members: Dr. Jack Berg and Ranee Berg (Three Forks Chiropractic); Dave Tudor (Tudor & Associates, Inc.); Julie Tudor (Whitetail Ranch Center), Ann Cole (First Community Bank), George Hoffman (Belgrade News), Glen Demaray (LCR Montana) and Christina Kamps (Main Street Office).

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Brooke.

Welcome Members and Visitors: Brooke introduced Mr. Jeff Elliott, the new Three Forks School Superintendent. Brooke appointed Jeff to fill the Chamber Board Member position that has been vacant due to Robert Do-Bell's resignation.

Approval of Minutes: The June 2018 unapproved minutes were sent prior to the meeting a motion to accept the meeting minutes was made by Dave and Ranee seconded.

Treasurer Report: Reports were sent prior to meeting. Tanya reviewed the Profit & Loss, Budget to Actuals, and Balance Sheet. Tanya provided an update on the CD with Stockman and the CD will be for 21 months at 2.25%. Membership sign up continued to increase since the last meeting and the budget goal is within \$5,000.00 now. Expenses to be paid: PayPay \$18.30 (Fees for Online Membership Signup & Vendor Fees), PayPal \$0.75 (Fees for Membership Signup), UI Contributions Bureau \$54.48 (UI Contributions), U.S. Treasury \$595.58 (Payroll Taxes), Diane Phillips \$199.90 (Stick Horses for Farmers Market), Linda Hessen \$90.86 (VIC Supplies), Seiler's Hardware \$2.52 (VIC Supplies), The Party People, LLC \$200.00 (Magic Show for Rodeo Dayz), Thriftway Super Stops #15 \$5.00 (Fun Money Reimbursement), Diane Phillps \$199.90 (Second Set of Stick Horses) and Main Street Office \$199.83 (Rodeo Dayz Advertising). Payrolls: Judy Harris \$50.05, Judith Hecker \$321.61, Linda Hessen \$467.07, Connie Hussung \$865.91, Katie LaLiberty \$276.23, Brooke McLees \$379.63, May McLees \$414.96, Carolyn Miller \$332,66, and

Fawn Venzor \$201.71. Main Street Office \$199.83 (Kelly made a motion to pay checks, JR seconded, motion approved.

Executive Secretary Report: There were 86 calls received/returned, 203 emails, 2 visitor packets, and 0 relocation packets sent. In addition to the general correspondence (emails, weekly bulletin, phone calls), Connie's roles this month included attending the Special Event Committee meetings for Rodeo Dayz and helping to organize for that event. Connie turned over the Phone Book listing spreadsheet to Main Street Office, who will begin working on ad placement and the phone book cover. Connie also updated the Fun Money with current members. The VIC is now open and Connie continues to support the staff there. Connie provided a Visitor Center Report that showed the area (state or country) and number of visitors from each area. Visitors came from 38 states and the District of Columbia with visitation being the highest from Montana (161) followed by Washington (48), Idaho (26) and California (24). There were nine visitors total from the countries of Australia, Canada, China, England and Germany.

Website Administrator Report: Katie provided an update on the new website, which is now up and running. Her main goal has been getting the website functional and now she is working on the front end on the visual end. Members are able to make payments using PayPal however, the check feature is not functioning properly and Katie is working to get this corrected. Katie mentioned that the Chamber cell phone is old and does not properly function. A motion was made by Tanya to purchase a new cell phone, up to \$150 and Karen seconded, the motion carried.

Chamber Committees: Members are welcome and are encouraged to participate on a committee. Anyone interested in volunteering, please contact Brooke (who serves on all Committees), Connie, or a committee head.

Civic & Economic Development Committee (Lane and Jeff): The first meeting of the Civic & Economic Development Committee will be held on Thursday, July 19th at noon at the VIC. With the re-structuring of the Chamber, this committee will be focus on Three Forks city and community development.

Special Events Committee (Karen and J.R): The Three Forks Road will be July 13 and 14 and there are many Chamber and/or Chamber Member sponsored events taking place. Vendor Registration and Parade Sign-Up form are on the Chamber website. Contact: Karen or Connie for Vendor information and Jack & Ranee Berg are heading up the parade line-up. Closing and opening of the road is being taken care of by members.
